Parent's Code of Conduct

- I will remember that all managers, coaches and board members are volunteers.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, managers, coaches and officials at every game.
- I will treat all players, managers, coaches and umpires with respect and will not criticize them in front of spectators; or use vulgar or abusive language.
- I will remember that the game is for the children – not the adults, and will do my best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will emphasize as a manager, coach or parent that doing one's best, being a good sport and being a good teammate are more important than winning.
- I will present my concerns to the manager or board member in PRIVATE.
- I will remember that the consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal substances on or near any ball field is PROHIBITED.
- I will require that my child's manager be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coach's Code of Conduct.
- Upon ejection from a game, your child can and will be subject to disciplinary action from a review board in addition to the automatic one game suspension invoked by the league. These penalties can range from an additional game(s) suspension up to and including immediate expulsion from the league with No Refund.

Player's Code of Conduct

- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, managers, coaches, and officials by demonstrating good sportsmanship myself.
- I will treat my manager, coaches, other player, umpires and fans with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will do my very best to listen to my coaches, because sports are an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I deserve to have fun during my sports experience and will alert my parents or coaches if it stops being fun.
- I will attend EVERY practice and game that I can, and will notify my manager if I cannot.
- I will encourage my parents to be involved with my team in some capacity because it is important to me.
- I will remember that playing the game and having fun is more important than winning every game.
- All players are responsible for their own actions ON or AT the baseball fields. Any behavior in violation of the "Player's Code of Conduct" will result in disciplinary action from a review board appointed by Garfield Hts. Baseball League, up to and including immediate expulsion from the league.
